- Walk through gorgeous national parkland of eucalyptus and stop at scenic viewpoints.
- Spot native wildlife such as kangaroos and koalas in their natural habitat.
- Take a guided treetop walk for a bird's eye view of the forest.
- Enjoy morning tea and a delicious homemade lunch while taking in views of the countryside and Brisbane city skyline.
- Cool off with a refreshing swim under a waterfall (optional, weather permitting).

Full Itinerary

This full-day Gold Coast adventure is by far our favorite and most popular experience in Southeast Queensland! Together with your local guide, you'll explore the Gold Coast Beach and Hinterland areas, complete with guided walks, great views and a tasty food stop.

We'll start our stunning nature walk with some scenic views, and a guided kangaroo and koala viewing excursion. We'll stop for morning tea at a lookout before heading off for more wildlife-spotting along 4WD tracks amongst a forest of Eucalyptus trees.

We'll continue with a rainforest walk to Curtis Falls in Tamborine National Park. The Tamborine escarpment is home to 85% of all the animal species found in the City of Gold Coast area, making it one of the best places to see native creatures in the wild. Be sure to bring your bathing suit, as we may be able to go swimming, weather permitting.

We'll stop to enjoy a homemade lunch at a spot that offers a view of both the countryside and the city skyline.

From the land to the sky, we'll take a fully guided treetop walk at O'Reillys Canopy, and go bird watching at Lamington National Park, which is part of the Gondwana Rainforests of Australia World Heritage area, and includes the most extensive areas of subtropical rainforest in the world.

At the end of your tour, we'll return you to your hotel or other drop-off point of your choice (please arrange with us the day prior

to your tour if you'd like an alternate drop-off than your hotel).

Inclusions: Local, experienced English-speaking guide, private transportation, morning tea with local fruit tasting, homemade snacks, lunch, sunscreen and insect repellent, binoculars and umbrellas for borrowed use.
