Full Itinerary

Your Surf City experience begins on an electric bicycle for a heady and picturesque ride down the Huntington Beach Bike Trail north to Sunset Beach, with a stop for a few snaps/selfies at Bolsa Chica State Beach. At Sunset Beach we'll sit and watch skilful locals surf the afternoon waves.

After a picturesque 25 min ride back to town, we'll return our bikes and walk to the International Surfing Museum. Here we'll spend some time learning about how surf culture has shaped the state of California and discover some of surfing's most beloved heroes.

We'll take a five-minute stroll along Main Street to the oldest brewery in Huntington Beach and one of our favorite watering holes. Here we'll enjoy a locally brewed beer and a bite to eat as we sit on the outdoor patio overlooking Main Street and the Pacific Ocean.

For our dessert, we'll gather around a fire pit on the beach and eat s'mores, hot dogs and potato chips while watching the

sunset. Can it get more USA than that?! We don't think so!

Before you go, your guide will be happy to give you recommendations on where to go once the sun has gone down and give you some tips on other things to see and during your stay in Orange County.
