Philadelphia is one of the oldest and most diverse cities in the nation — now you have a chance to discover the city where America was born.

Start your private tour by driving to the heart of Philadelphia's history: Old City, the Historic District and Independence National Park. See the locations where America was first forged, like Independence Hall. Learn the true stories behind some of America's most iconic items, like the Liberty Bell and the Betsy Ross House. And discover how this original neighborhood has transformed into one of the most vibrant areas of the city over the last 250+ years.

Next, head into Center City, where the buildings are bigger and the energy is electric! Check out the incredible Philadelphia City Hall and the newly renovated Dilworth Park, home of the iconic Love Sculpture. This instantly-recognizable art piece is a photo opportunity you won't want to pass up.

Then you'll head to the real South Philly! The 9th Street Italian Market is one of the most eclectic areas of the city. This vibrant and active market is the largest daily farmers' market in the country and is the heart of Philadelphia's Italian community. Peruse vendors and shops that carry on the generations of tradition — and offer delicious food of all kinds. You might even have a chance to stop and grab a snack or treat!

Finally, you'll make your way to one of the main attractions for Philadelphia visitors: The Rocky Steps. These 72 steps lead up to the Philadelphia Museum of Art, at the end of the Benjamin Franklin Parkway. You'll have the opportunity to get out of the van and run them yourself (hint: don't underestimate them). From the top, you'll find the imprint of Rocky's Converse and a beautiful view of Philadelphia's skyline. Then, once you've caught your breath and raised your fists in the air, head back down the steps to take a picture with the real Rocky statue — a must see for every visitor to Philadelphia.

When your tour is over, and after you've made memories that will last a lifetime, your guide will be happy to drop you off at a location of your choice — maybe even their favorite spot to grab that other Philadelphia icon, the Philly cheesesteak. Your guide will also be happy to give you recommendations for other restaurants or other attractions throughout the city.
