Spend a relaxing afternoon getting to know all about the beer scene in Punta Arenas. Join an expert local guide and start off at one of the oldest breweries in Chile where you'll see the beer-making process and taste the seven beers they produce. Switching gears, you'll also visit a local bar to taste a few craft brews while sipping among locals. What could be better than getting to know a new city through its beer?

Full Itinerary

Your beer tour of Punta Arenas starts at the city's main square where you will meet your local guide. From here we'll take a scenic walk through the colonial area of Punta Arenas to Austral Brewery, the oldest brewery in Punta Arenas and one of the most popular in Chile.

Once at the brewery, we will take a tour of the facilities and learn all about the beer-making process, from the selection of malted barley to bottling, as well as the history behind the barley to bottle process.

After this dose of beer-making facts and history, it will be time for the best part: tasting! At the showroom, we will have the honor of tasting all the beers that the factory produces (7 types) and choose our favorite. Following our tour and tasting, we will take a private car or van to get to our next stop, which (naturally) includes more beer.

Our second beer stop is an authentic local bar where you'll have the chance to sip among locals, learning more about the people of Punta Arenas and how they like to socialize.

At the bar you will have the chance to enjoy 3 types of local craft beer and taste the differences between the industrial beer we tried earlier

and artisanal beer, both made with the purest water on the planet.

The tour will end at the bar. Feel free to stay as long as you want, or your local guide can direct you back to your accommodations or other great places to drink in the city.

Additional information

Inclusions: Local English-speaking guide, tour of Austral Brewery, 10 different types of beer tastings, car or van transportation from factory to the end point.

Exclusions: Food during the tour, tips/gratuities for your guide.

Dress standard: In Patagonia you can experience four seasons in one day, so we recommend you wear hiking shoes and multiple layers of clothing, including a rain and windproof layer. Please don't forget your sunscreen, sunglasses and sun hat. Local tip: If it is raining, don't bother to bring an umbrella, as the wind usually breaks them. We recommend a waterproof jacket with hood instead.

Your Trip: For your Urban Adventure you will be in a small group of a maximum of 12 people.

Confirmation of booking: If you have your voucher, your booking is confirmed. We'll see you at the start point. Get in touch if you have any concerns or require more information via the email address or phone number (business hours only) on your voucher.

Additional Information: In Chile, we have a National Emergency Office (ONEMI).
