Get a flavourful introduction to windswept Punta Arenas on an action-packed half-day tour. Discover the city's highlights, channel Ernest Shackleton's unbreakable spirit as you heroically climb a small hill (a stunning view across the city awaits) and taste the best Patagonian dishes in town. Go ahead and get acquainted with one of the world's most southerly cities with a local by your side, because every great explorer needs a little help occasionally!

Highlights

- Explore the highlights of Punta Arenas and hear the stories of the indigenous people, settlers and adventurers that once called this city home
- Taste a typical Magallenic breakfast of choriqueso (bread with chorizo and cheese) and banana milk
- Take a wander around one of the most beautiful cemeteries in the world
- Support local fishermen with a visit to the seafood market to taste the best king crab empanada in all of Chile (and maybe pick up some souvenirs too!)

- Stroll along the coast spotting dolphins and colourful street murals

Full Itinerary

Your tour begins in the historical centre of Punta Arenas, the place where it all began. Your local guide will talk about the history of the city as they lead you to the first stop of the day, which is perfect if you've not had breakfast yet. Choriqueso and banana milk is the breakfast of choice for local Patagonians and you'll see why as we taste them both at one of our favourite local spots.

After filling up with a traditional breakfast, we'll walk it off with a gentle stroll along the coast, admiring spectacular sea views. Make sure you keep an eye open for dolphins and albatross. We'll pass by some beautiful street art murals and stop to take plenty of photos.

Our walk continues to one of the most beautiful cemeteries in the world. We'll introduce you to some of the residents and give

you plenty of time to explore this peaceful hidden gem.

We'll head back to the city centre next, either on foot or via public transport — depending of the weather of the day! Along the way we'll stop to visit the viewpoint on La Cruz Hill, where we'll enjoy fabulous views across the colourful city of Punta Arenas with the Strait of Magellan as a backdrop.

Our tour will end with even more delicious local food. This time we're hitting up the seafood market where quality handicrafts and mouth-watering street food go hand in hand. We'll take you to a special spot where you will try the best king crab empanada and calafate sour cocktail of your life!

Local legend suggests that if you try the calafate sour, you will definitely come back to Patagonia. We hope this is true so that we can welcome you back again! Before you go, don't forget to ask your local guide for more tips on what else to see, do and eat during your stay.

Additional information

Inclusions: Local English-speaking guide, two food tastings, one banana milk, one calafate sour cocktail or alternative drink, public transport tickets, cemetery entrance fee.

Dress standard: In Patagonia you can experience four seasons in one day, so we recommend you wear hiking shoes and multiple layers of clothing, including a rain and windproof layer. Please don't forget your sunscreen, sunglasses and sun hat.
Local tip: If it is raining, don't bother to bring an umbrella, as the wind usually breaks them. We recommend a waterproof jacket with hood instead.

Your Trip: For your Urban Adventure you will be in a small group of a maximum of 12 people.

Confirmation of booking: If you have your voucher, your booking is confirmed. We'll see you at the start point. Get in touch if you have any concerns or require more information via the email address or phone number (business hours only) on your voucher

Additional Information: In Chile we have a National Emergency Office (ONEMI). In the unlikely event of an emergency situation, natural disaster or natural event, they can order park, road and maritime crossing closures. Therefore, in cases of emergencies in the region of Magellan and the Chilean Antarctic, we are governed by what ONEMI says. We will notify you of any tour cancellations with as much notice as we can.

Closure of sites: Sometimes for reasons beyond our control, Kiosko Roca (a traditional restaurant) can be closed or crowded. If so, your guide will take you to a similar venue.

Child Policy: This is a child-friendly tour. Children between the ages of 6 and 11 inclusively are permitted on this tour at the rate

listed above. Please select 'child' above when booking. Children under the age of 6 are permitted to join this tour free of charge. Please inform us at the time of booking if you'll be bringing a child under the age of 6. You can do so in the special request box on the checkout page.
