One-time British outpost and now a proud member of the People's Republic of China, Hong Kong has had a long and fascinating history. The history of the last century for both Hong Kong and China is mapped out in its streets for those who know where to look.

This tour begins at Sheung Wan, specifically at Possession Point, where the British proclaimed Hong Kong to be part of their empire. It finishes at the Tamar Government Complex in Admiralty, once a dockyard of the Royal British Navy and now the headquarters of China's Hong Kong Special Administrative Regional Government.

While this 3.5 hours tour is about the history of Hong Kong, we will also talk about what's going on now for and where it is heading to in the future. You're sure to finish this tour with a unique insight and understanding of Hong Kong that will enhance the rest of your stay here.
