If you're working the Iguassu Falls circuit, then why not hit up the Argentine side of the falls with us? You'll get to see it from different points.

Full Itinerary

You're here — why not see Iguassu Falls from the Argentinian side too! We'll start the day early, heading towards the Brazil-Argentina border and immigration control. Once across we'll be driving for about 20 minutes to reach Iguazu National Park.

Upon arrival, we'll head to the train station, where we catch the train to Devil's Throat Station on the Argentinian side of the falls. From here, we'll continue by foot on a catwalk (2,000 meters round trip) above the Iguassu River, where we'll be treated to an amazing view of the still waters before they make their descent over the falls into a raging torrent of water.

After this epic view of the Devil's Throat, we'll grab the train back so we can access the Upper Circuit, where we'll enjoy even more spectacular views of the Iguassu River, before a 45-minute walk through the Iguassu Forest.

We'll continue our walk, this time on the Lower Circuit, introducing us to the Iguassu Canyon. At 1,400 meters, it's here that we really have the opportunity to feel the falls. And since we're in Argentina, we really should try one of the country's best culinary creations - the empanada!

The empanada tasting can be done either before or after the lower trail depending on how hungry you are.

Once we are done, the last stop will be a break for lunch, with the option of even more empanadas if you didn't get enough

earlier! Or you can grab a sandwich or a buffet meal. (Please note that lunch is not included in the price of the tour.)

From here, we'll head back to the town of Foz do Iguassu where our tour of Iguassu Falls Argentina will come to a close!

Important: Please note that we will need your passport details at the time of booking, in order to prepare for your border crossing. Having this information in advance will help to make our group's crossing as quickly as possible. Please provide your full name, date of birth, nationality, and passport number in the "Additional information" box at checkout. You will also need to bring your passport, and visa and entry/exit fee for Argentina (note that the fee and visa requirements vary depending on your nationality — please check your local government website).

Additional information

Inclusions: Local English-speaking guide, transportation as indicated, empanada tasting.

Exclusions: Entrance fee to Iguassu Falls National Park, souvenirs and items of a personal nature, food and drinks, tips/gratuities for your guide.

Dress standard: Please wear comfortable clothes and shoes for walking. Note that in summer months, the temperature can reach 40 degrees Celsius (in winter, you will need warmer clothes, although temperatures can also get to 20 degrees Celsius). Bring sunscreen and bug repellent. A rain jacket or poncho is also encouraged if you don't want to get wet from the mist of the falls.

Your Trip: For your Urban Adventure you will be in a small group of a maximum of 12 people.

Confirmation of booking: If you have your voucher, your booking is confirmed. We'll see you at your hotel for pick up. Please check your hotel details are correct on the voucher. If your details are not correct, it is very important to please email us to confirm your correct pick up hotel using the contact details on the voucher. If you prefer you may also phone the change through to us during business hours.

Additional Information: Note that you must have your visa and reciprocity fee to Argentina, as these fees cannot be paid at the border.

Child Policy: This is a child-friendly tour. Children between the ages of 7 and 11 inclusively are permitted on this tour at the rate listed above. Please select 'child' above when booking. Children under the age of 7 are permitted to join this tour free of charge. Please inform us at the time of booking if you'll be bringing a child under the age of 7.
